Our Gift Partners and Volunteers helped us do amazing things!

TOTAL UNIQUE STUDENTS SERVED in our core programs alone. This is the second year in a row we've achieved record enrollment in our tutoring, mentoring, and summer learning programs (with waiting lists for Summer Learning and Tutoring).

YOUTH TUTORED & FED DAILY. Students who attend our after-school tutoring program came hungry each day. So that they had fuel for another two hours of learning, we provided a meal and/or snack to our K-12th grade students. For some, it was the best meal of the evening.



WEEKENDER BAGS DISTRIBUTED

MONTHLY. This growing program provides six small meals for students who don't have enough to eat on weekends, when school isn't providing free breakfast and lunch. We distributed Weekender Bags through six Danbury public schools.

FAMILIES FED MONTHLY. More than 400 families are members of our Food Pantry, coming biweekly (some, weekly) to receive meat, dairy, fresh produce, bakery and nonperishable staples. With each family numbering 3-6, we provided food for about 2,000 individuals every month.

ACTIVE PATIENTS. Our Samaritan Health Center provides low-cost physicals, immunizations, and sick care to those in Danbury without healthcare plans. It has 1,200 pediatric patient files, and logged 872 appointments this past fiscal year.
